Repeated offenses will be entered into your rental record and remain in your rental history.

As the holiday season is approaching, E.P. Management wants to recommend to any residents that shop online for home delivery to use UPS as much as possible. We have registered a complaint with Fed Ex about their drivers not delivering packages to the individual units in the building. We have had several Fed Ex packages be delivered and left in the main lobby areas. For obvious reasons, this is not supposed to happen! E.P. Management



does not want anyone's packages to come up missing because the delivery was not made correctly. The drivers that deliver from UPS always deliver directly to the individual apartments as expected. You are not required to use one service over the other, but please be aware that Fed Ex does not always follow the proper procedures. If you are unhappy with your deliveries with either agency, you too can register a complaint if you so choose. Please keep this in mind as you do your holiday shopping online this season.

Lost and Found Keys

There is now a lost and found basket for keys located near the office door. If you should find someone's keys please do one of the following:

- Leave the keys where they are. The person who has either lost or left their keys behind will most likely return to the last spot that they remember having their keys at. If they are hanging in a mailbox door, then leave them in the mailbox door.

OR

- Place the keys in the lost and found basket. This will be a "common area" that all residents should know to be looking should they ever misplace their keys.



Do not put the keys in the mailbox slot in the office. The reason we do not want you to do this is because the resident may not be able to get their keys back until the next day if it is after hours.
